

TRANSFER CREDIT EVALUATION PROCESS

Once you've been accepted, submit your tuition deposit to begin the transfer credit process. After the deposit is received, we'll evaluate courses taken at other institutions or through high school programs such as AP, CLEP, or IB.

Your credits will be posted on your OASIS account within 10 days of receipt of your tuition deposit. If you do NOT have an associate degree, only courses with grades of C or better will be considered for transfer.

International students are required to have a course-by-course evaluation from a NACES approved service. For more information visit naces.org.

International students' transcripts must include descriptions (in English) for each course submitted for credit. Contact your prior institution(s) for course descriptions.

ACCREDITATION

Courses taken at regionally accredited institutions (such as colleges accredited by Middle States) are more likely to be accepted. Non-accredited courses will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis.

Students who have earned an associate degree and are admitted to the College are generally awarded full transfer credit for their coursework. The total number of credits required for graduation depends on the remaining courses needed to fulfill both College and major requirements.

Generally, courses with a grade of C or better will transfer. However, many majors require a C+ or better for a course to satisfy a major's requirement.

Although a course transferred in with a C grade will earn credits, the transfer course may not satisfy the requirement of the major and the course may have to be repeated. AP test grades of 3 or higher may earn credits.


