Matriculated Students

- Must apply using either the SUNY or Common Application found on our website.
- Both applications require a \$50 application fee. A SUNY Fee Waiver is available for those who qualify.
- Formally accepted into a certificate or degree program (Associates, Bachelors or Masters).
- Eligible for Financial Aid (Federal & State) if proper documentation is provided (FAFSA: Free Application for Federal Student Aid) to the Financial Aid Office.
- Priority registration. Matriculated students will be able to register for classes before nonmatriculated students.
- Eligible to participate in one of our Division III Sports teams.

Non-Matriculated Students

- Not formally enrolled in a degree program. Credits earned can be applied toward a degree at Farmingdale State College or at another institution.
- Must complete the Non-Matriculated Student Application on our website and pay a non-refundable \$50 application fee.
- Not eligible for Financial Aid.
- Do not have priority registration (unless student is a Veteran) and must wait until nonmatriculated registration opens.
- Limited to 5 courses and a maximum of 16 credits per semester.
- Can earn a maximum of 32 credits, after which must seek admission to a degree program or request permission to continue taking courses.

Both Matriculated and Non-Matriculated Students...

- Receive Academic Advisement.
- Pay the same tuition & fees for in-state and out-of-state residents.
- Can utilize the resources Farmingdale State College offers (e.g., Tutoring, Library, Computer Lab, Nexus Career Center, Clubs & Organizations).
- Eligible to complete a Student Housing Application and live on campus.
- Must maintain Farmingdale State College's academic standards, i.e., a grade point average of 2.0 or above to remain in good academic standing (a GPA of 2.0 will not ensure admission to a student's preferred program).
