Plastic Is So Last Semester

FSC says goodbye to single-use plastics

Farmingdale State College and its affiliated organizations are required to eliminate the use of single-use plastic items in accordance with SUNY Policy 5201: Elimination of Single Use Plastics and Preference for Durable and Reusable Alternatives. As required by SUNY Procedure 5200 .

FSC has created a FSC Plastic Elimination Plan for reducing plastic use and improving recycling practices on campus.

Department Heads:

To help meet the waste reduction goals of our Eight for '28 Strategic Plan, FSC is eliminating single-use plastic items across all departments by:

- **Stop disposable** use where possible by changing habits and operations.
- **Choose compostable**, plastic-free products when disposables are needed.
- **Prefer recycled plastic** only if no other alternatives exist—with higher recycled content as the goal.

Department heads will track and report all single-use purchases (including third-party spending) annually using the Plastics Elimination Form. This helps the Office for Sustainability monitor campus-wide progress.

Electrical Hazard Safety

FSC is stepping up electrical safety through key enhancements to its Lockout/Tagout (LOTO) Program, which protects Trades staff from dangerous energy sources during repairs and installations.

The Environmental Health & Safety (EHS) Office provided training so staff understand how to follow the proper safety procedures. New LOTO stations have been installed across campus, and personal kits were given to employees who need them. These safety updates help prevent accidents and keep our campus safe.
