

CAMPER CODE OF CONDUCT

Camp Farmingdale, located at The Children’s Center at Farmingdale State College, takes the safety of all children very seriously. The emotional and physical well-being of each child is our utmost concern; therefore we ask that parents go over the Code of Conduct, as listed below, with their child. Please sign below to verify that both you and your child understand the expectations of all campers.

- All campers are expected to respect their counselors, and follow directions at all times.
- All campers are expected to show respect to all other campers. They will not use profanity, or be negative towards another camper in any way.
- All campers are expected to be within sight of a counselor at all times. Campers may not be in the building unless they are accompanied by a counselor.
- All campers are expected to remain with a counselor at all times when off premises, at a scheduled field trip.
- Campers will not use physical means to resolve a conflict.
- All campers are expected to use furniture and equipment in the manner in which it is intended, (i.e. chairs for sitting, tables for eating or working on projects.)
- All campers are expected to engage in the activities planned throughout the day.
- Campers shall not engage in any dangerous activity that may threaten the safety of themselves or any other camper.
- All cell phones, iPods, iPads, etc. should remain at home. Parents and children can communicate through the phone at the center, 631-420-2125. Any electronics brought to camp will be held at the main desk until the end of the day.

Campers who do not follow any of the guidelines above may receive disciplinary warning, lose trip privileges, or be expelled from the camp without refund.
