


FSC Holiday Hangout

Students enrolled in EGL 310, Technical Writing, were completing their capstone project, which required developing and presenting a proposal to enhance campus life at FSC and support student enrollment.

Tyniah Smith, the group's liaison, contacted CP&C to explore the feasibility of converting Hicks Hall into a comfortable campus lounge featuring nap areas and quiet spaces.

Project Coordinator Joe V, met with the group and provided reference photos, historical information about the building, and insight for potential budgets and timelines, allowing the students to refine their proposal and position it as a competitive project.

The group presented their final proposal to the class on December 3, 2025. It was a pleasure working with the students and seeing their enthusiasm and creativity focused on enhancing the FSC campus experience.
