

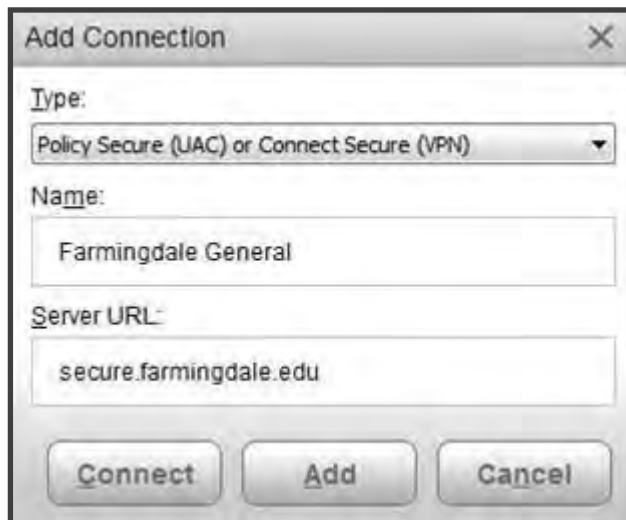
Pulse Secure

Once Pulse Secure is installed, you need to manually setup a connection to the secure.farmingdale.edu server.

Open the Pulse Secure program and click the “+” tab to add a connection.



In the Add Connection dialog box, enter the settings exactly as show below. When done click “Add” to save your settings.



Then click “Connect” to start your login.




When prompted, enter your Farmingdale email username and password.

Once connect to the VPN, you can access the below...

Banner – in Google Chrome type: <https://www.farmingdale.edu/banner>

Network Share Drives – To access network shares, the drive has to be "mapped".

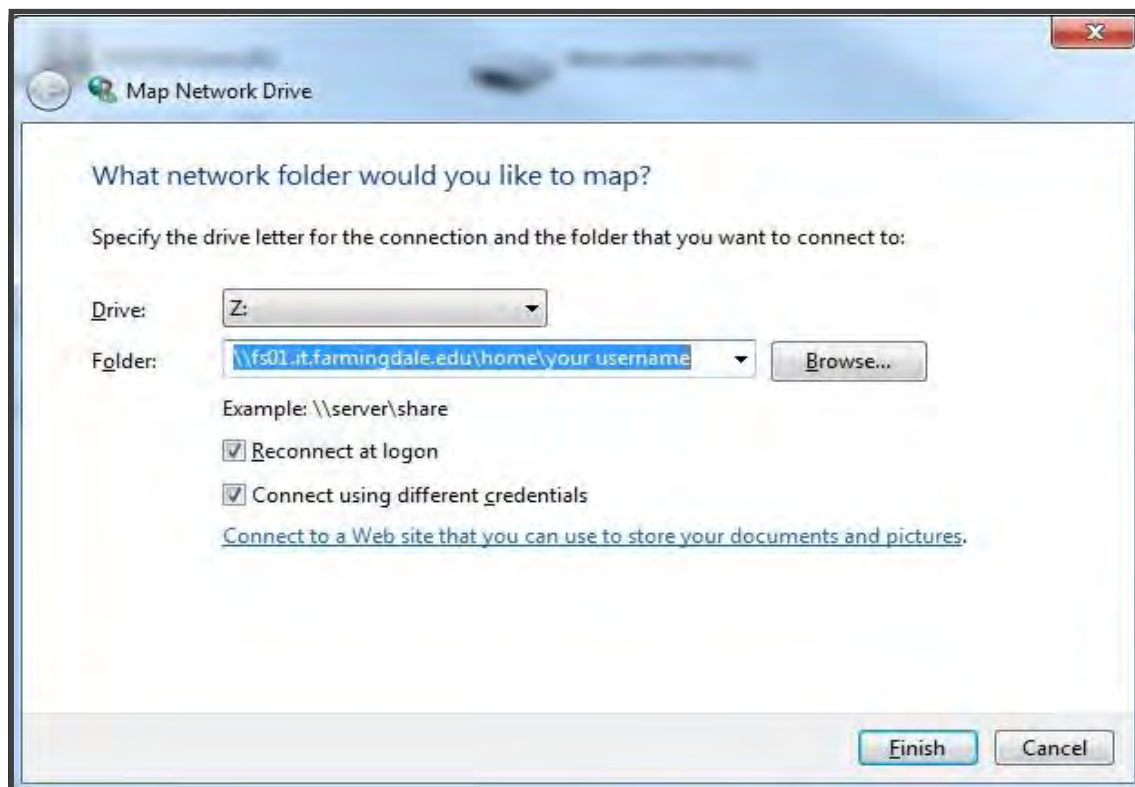
For Windows 7 Click the "Start" button
 Select "Computer"
 Select "Map network drive" at the top of the window

For Windows 10 Press  + E to open a File Explorer window (Win key + E)
 Choose "This PC" from the left side of the window
 Click the "Computer" tab
 Click the "Map Network Drive" button

Fill in the path to the drive in the "Folder" text box as shown in the below example.

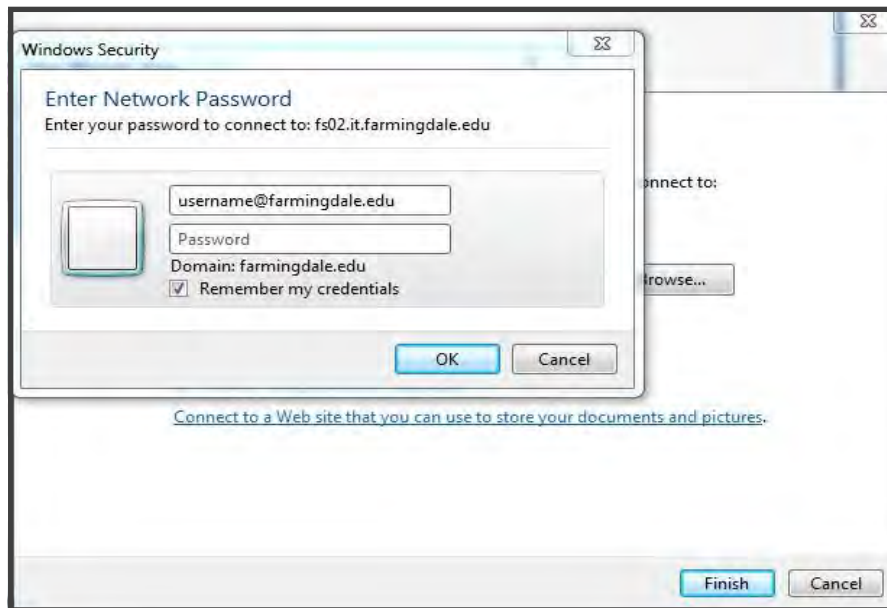
Home Drive (J)	\\fs01.it.farmingdale.edu\home\username
Other Network Shares	\\fs02.it.farmingdale.edu\groups\sharename

Put a check mark in both boxes as shown. Click Finish.



Enter network credentials as shown below: username@farmingdale.edu

Enter your email password and check mark if you want your laptop to remember your credentials.



*****When you are done using the network share drive for the day, right click the drive and select Disconnect. The drive will disappear from the File Explorer.**
