Key Findings

Graduate Students

- Enrollment in the Master of Science in Technology Management program continues to decrease, there were 30 students in Fall 2024, compared to 33 in Fall 2023 and 70 in Fall 2020. That's a 9% drop and a 63% drop versus 2020.
- Fifty percent (50%) of the new enrollees for Fall 2024 received their undergraduate degree from Farmingdale State College.
- This program is predominantly male (87%) with 87% of the students attending on a part-time basis and 13% on a full-time basis.

Undergraduate Students

- SUNY enrollment has seen a modest increase of 2.1% since 2023, with the Technology College sector experiencing the most significant growth at 4.9%. Between Fall 2023 and Fall 2024, our enrollment rose by 499 students, or 5.2%, representing the average growth rate in the Technology Colleges sector. We lead the sector with the highest enrollment, exceeding 10,000 students.
- Enrollment among Hispanic, Black/African American, and Asian students has remained stable, constituting over half (54%) of the total undergraduate student population. Additionally, nearly one-third (31%) of all first-time students identified as Hispanic/Latino. Farmingdale has been a majority-minority institution for the past four years.
- The percentage of male students dropped slightly, by 0.6%, although it has remained fairly consistent at around 59%.
- Our New Student Enrollment numbers shows that first-time college student enrollment increased by 160 students, or 9.3%, following last year's 5.8% increase, external transfer enrollment rose by 3.9%. Our one-year retention rate for first-time, full-time bachelor's degree-seeking student improved to 82% from 81% in the previous year.
- In Fall 2024, the percentage of accepted degree-seeking students among those who applied was 65%, and the percentage of enrolled degree-seeking students among those who accepted was 27%. Since 2021, the number of first-time degree-seeking applicants has increased by 49%, whereas the acceptance and enrollment rates have decreased by 7% and 5%, respectively.
- The average High School GPA of our incoming full-time, bachelor's degree-seeking freshmen had a slight improvement, rising to 89.8 from 89.6 last year. Similarly, the average SAT score increased to 1144 from 1119. Submission of an SAT or ACT score was optional for Fall 2024, and 24% of incoming full-time, bachelor's degree-seeking freshmen choose to submit an SAT or ACT score.
- The top three baccalaureate curriculums with the largest percentage increases in enrollment over 2023 are Aeronautical Science: Professional Pilot (46%), Applied Mathematics (33%), and Construction Management Engineering Technology (29%).
- Same as last year, the most popular curriculums among new first-time students are Liberal Arts & Sciences (23%), Science, Technology & Society (22%), and Business Management (8%).
- Science, Technology & Society (25%) and Business Management (15%) remain the top two curriculums into which new transfer students enrolled.
- The top three baccalaureate programs with the highest enrollment are Science, Technology, & Society (1,758), Business Management (1,144), and Computer Science (419).
- The top three feeder high schools are Brentwood High School (159), Lindenhurst High School (129), and Walt Whitman High School (112). Of the top 50 feeder high schools, Amityville Memorial High School had the highest percentage of accepted students who registered at 62%.
- The top colleges that students transferred in from are Suffolk County Community (276), Nassau Community (246), SUNY at Stony Brook (30), SUNY at Old Westbury (21), and CUNY Queensborough Community College (20).
- Non-matriculated students increased by 64 students to a total of 455 students.





Fall 2024 Graduate Student Enrollment Summary












