## Fall 2025 Enrollment Report

### Key Findings

#### Graduate Students

- Enrollment in the Master of Science in Technology Management program continues to decline. The program enrolled 24 students in Fall 2025, compared with 30 students in Fall 2024 and 70 students in Fall 2020. This represents a 20% decrease from Fall 2024 and a 66% decrease from Fall 2020. This program is predominantly male (88%) with 68% of students attend part-time, while 32% attend full-time.
- The Master of Science in Nursing Administration, a new online program, became effective in Fall 2025 and enrolled 19 students in its first term. The program is entirely female. This program with 84% of the students attending on a full-time basis and 16% on a part-time basis.
- Thirty-three percent (33%) of the new enrollees for Fall 2025 received their undergraduate degree from Farmingdale State College.

#### Undergraduate Students

- SUNY enrollment has increased modestly by 3.5% since 2024, with the Community College sector showing the strongest growth at 5.1%. The Technology College sector also saw a slight increase of 1.5%. Between Fall 2024 and Fall 2025, our enrollment grew by 55 students, or 0.5%. Maritime had the highest growth rate within the Technology Colleges sector at 9%. We also continue to lead the sector in total enrollment, with more than 10,000 students.
- Enrollment among Hispanic, Black/African American, and Asian students have remained stable, constituting over half (56%) of the total undergraduate student population. Additionally, nearly one-third (31%) of all first-time students identified as Hispanic/Latino. Farmingdale has been a majority-minority institution for the past five years.
- The percentage of male students remained fairly consistent at around 58%.
- Our New Student Enrollment numbers shows that first-time college student enrollment decreased by 5.9%, following last year's 9.3% increase; external transfer enrollment also decreased by 5.6% following last year 3.9% increase. Our one-year retention rate for first-time, full-time bachelor's degree-seeking student improved to 83% from 82% in the previous year.
- In Fall 2025, the percentage of accepted first-time degree-seeking students among those who applied was 62%, and the percentage of enrolled degree-seeking students among those who accepted was 24%. Since 2021, the number of first-time degree-seeking applicants has increased by 64%, whereas the acceptance and enrollment rates have decreased by 11% and 8%, respectively.
- The average high school GPA of incoming full-time, bachelor's degree-seeking freshmen remained relatively stable at 89.6, compared with 89.8 last year. The average SAT score decreased from 1,144 to 1,129. For Fall 2025, submission of SAT or ACT scores was optional, and 19% of incoming full-time, bachelor's degree-seeking freshmen chose to submit a score.
- The top three baccalaureate curriculums with the largest percentage increases in enrollment over 2024 are Artificial Intelligence Management (155%), Nursing RN to BS online (88%), and Global Business Management (54%).
- Same as last year, the most popular curriculums among new first-time students are Liberal Arts & Sciences (24%), Science, Technology & Society (22%), and Business Management (8%).
- Science, Technology & Society (23%) and Business Management (16%) remain the top two curriculums into which new transfer students enrolled.
- The top three baccalaureate programs with the highest enrollment are Science, Technology, & Society (1,829), Business Management (1,175), and Computer Prog & Info Systems (373).
- The top three feeder high schools are Brentwood High School (201), Lindenhurst High School (125), and Walt Whitman High School (113). Of the top 50 feeder high schools, Central Islip High School had the highest percentage of accepted students who registered at 51%.
- The top colleges that students transferred in from are Suffolk County Community (296), Nassau Community (246), CUNY Queensborough Community College (18), SUNY at Stony Brook (17), and Hofstra University (17).
- Non-matriculated students decreased by 53 to a total of 402 students.
