


Before you create Wufoo forms...

- 1) All Wufoo forms that use PEI (Personal Identifiable Information) fields such as RAMID, SSN, DOB, etc., these fields must be encrypted (<http://bit.ly/1MbtV2Y>). If there's already a form with these fields not encrypted, the form must be recreated from scratch to encrypt those fields.
- 2) To embed the form in OU Campus:
 - a. In Wufoo, go to "Share" and under "Embed Code" copy the code provided.
 - b. In OU Campus, create an asset type "Source Code" and paste the code there. Save and publish the asset.
 - c. In OU Campus go to the page where you want to embed your form, i.e. farmingdale.edu/my-directory/wufoo-form.shtml and insert the asset you just created. Save and publish the page.
 - d. You **MUST** provide the link as a full address starting with <https://>. So for the example above, you would provide this link to your audience: <https://www.farmingdale.edu/my-directory/wufoo-form.shtml>. You will also use this link for left navigations, links from other pages, etc.
 - e. Visual instructions attached.

How to properly embed a Wufoo form in OU Campus

1. Select the "Forms" tab, search for your form name in the "Filter" field, and click on "Share"



2. Scroll down to "Embed Your Form On Your Site" and copy the code provided next to "Embed Code"



Under Assets, select arrow next to "New" and choose "Source Code"


