

## CORONAVIRUS: CREDITS AND REFUNDS REQUEST TO HOLD CREDIT FROM SPRING 2020 TO FALL 2020

All students will receive a prorated credit to their account, *where applicable*, for room, board, other meal plans, many broad-based fees, and certain course fees. The calculation of the amount of the credit is based on a SUNY established departure date of March 19 through the conclusion of the semester on May 15.

Students with an account that is paid in full or that has a balance less than the credited amount will receive a refund from the College.

Students who would prefer to transfer the credit to a subsequent semester rather than receive a direct refund from the College should sign and return this form to the Office of Student Accounts by Wednesday, May 6, 2020.

Please note: Federal regulations do not allow the College to hold a credit from Title IV financial aid funds in the current aid year to a future aid year. Title IV funds include grants (PELL, and SEOG) as well as loan funds (Direct Stafford Subsidized and Unsubsidized, and Direct Parent PLUS Loans). If your account includes TIV funds, we will not hold the credit, but will issue you a refund, if applicable.
