Withdrawal Liability & Refund Schedule — Spring 2026

Tuition and fee reductions follow SUNY Board of Trustees policies. Students must complete official drop or withdrawal procedures by the published deadlines. Non-payment, check cancellation, or non-attendance does **not** count as withdrawal and does **not** cancel financial responsibility. The college does **not** automatically drop unpaid schedules, and liability will not be waived.

Refund eligibility is based on the date the drop or withdrawal is processed. Dropping during the 100% refund period results in no liability. After that, reductions follow the posted schedule. Note: After the 100% period, **College Fee, Transcript Fee, First Day/Inclusive Access Fees, Special Course/Lab Fees, and Curriculum Fees are non-refundable.**

If a deadline falls on a weekend or outside office hours, drops must be processed **online**. Students with **financial holds** cannot drop online and must contact the Registrar's Office during business hours.

SPRING 2026 — Full Term (January 26 – May 20)

- On or before Feb 1 - 100% refund
- Feb 2–8 - 70% refund
- Feb 9–15 - 50% refund
- Feb 16–22 - 30% refund
- Feb 23 or later - 0% refund

SPRING 2026 — 7-Week 1 (January 26 – March 23)

- On or before Feb 1 - 100% refund
- Feb 2–8 - 35% refund
- Feb 9 or later - 0% refund

SPRING 2026 — 12-Week Session (January 31 – April 18)

- On or before Feb 6 - 100% refund
- Feb 7–13 - 60% refund
- Feb 14–20 - 40% refund
- Feb 21 or later - 0% refund

SPRING 2026 — 7-Week 2 (March 25 – May 13)

- On or before Mar 31 - 100% refund
- Apr 1–7 - 35% refund
- Apr 8 or later - 0% refund
