COST EXPLANATION

Tuition and College Fee – SUNY students pay tuition and fees at their home campus. Mandatory college fee varies per institution. The tuition and fees are estimates. SUNY tuition and fees are subject to change without notice by action of the SUNY Board of Trustees.

FSC Overseas Academic Program Fee – This fee is used to cover the administrative and operational costs of this program.

Overseas Academic Program Differential – This sum covers the cost of lodging and excursions. The sum displayed is based upon a double room with AC. **A double room with no AC is \$250 less.**

Health and Medevac Insurance – All study abroad participants are required to purchase the SUNY mandated health insurance policy. This policy includes evacuation, repatriation and traveler assistance coverage. (This is not Travelers insurance).

Projected Expenses – These are estimated fees and vary due to exchange rate fluctuations and personal spending habits.
