Topic: Capitalization

Definition: The action of writing or printing in capital letters.

Explanation: Capitalization means using capital, or upper case, letters. Capitalization is required in specific circumstances:

Examples

- The first word in a sentence
 - o Ex. The dog is thirsty.
- The pronoun "I"
 - o Ex. My day off was ruined when I had to clean my house.
- Proper nouns: the names of specific people, places, and organizations.
 - o Ex. My best friend, Sally, is a generous person.
- Family relationships when used as proper nouns
 - o Ex. My Mom is very smart.
- Days of the week, month, and holidays
 - o Ex. This year Christmas falls on a Saturday.
- Members of national, political, racial, social, civic, and athletic groups
 - o Ex. The New York Yankees are a talented baseball team.
- Periods and events
 - o Ex. The Roaring Twenties was a decade of prosperity and joy.
- Trademarks
 - o Ex. Coca-Cola is a popular drink.
